

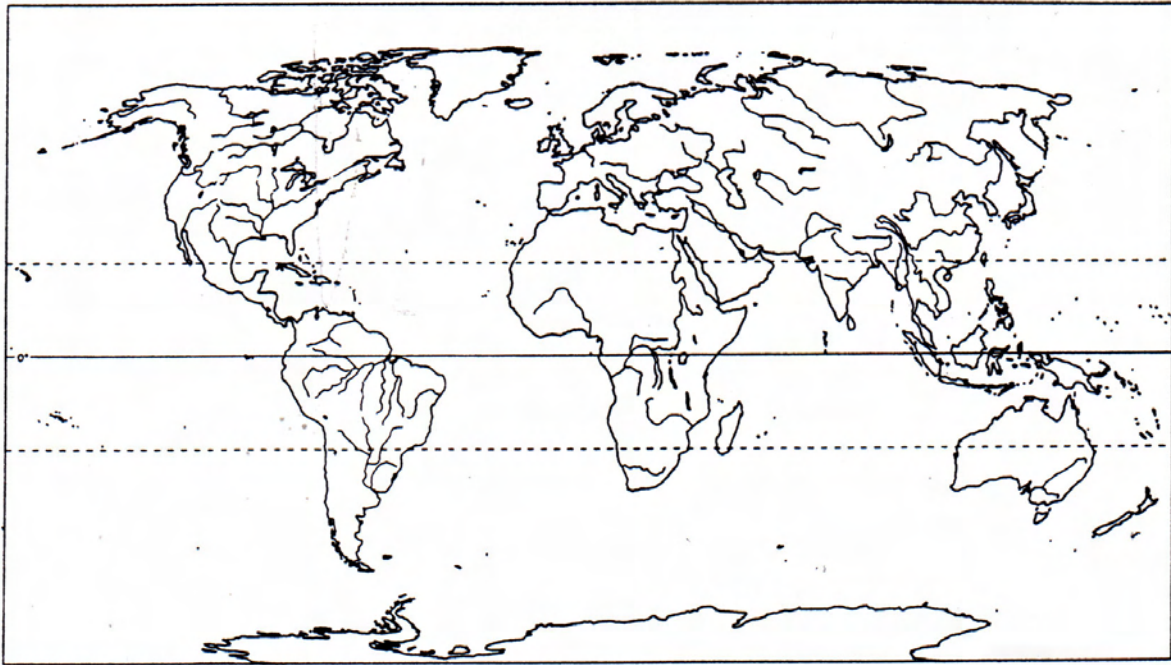
MAP EXERCISE
