- 3) Evaluate how the end of World War II impacted the states of the Pacific Rim.
- 4) Identify the reasons for the enormous economic growth of Japan and the Pacific Rim after 1945.
- 5) Evaluate why the Communists and not the Guomindang achieved permanent success.
- 6) Define how Mao's political beliefs affected the nature of the Communist system after 1945.
- 7) Trace the gains women achieved in China, Japan, and the Pacific Rim states after 1945.
- 8) Trace how the French gained control of Vietnam.
- 9) Compare China and Vietnam culturally before and after the revolutions.
